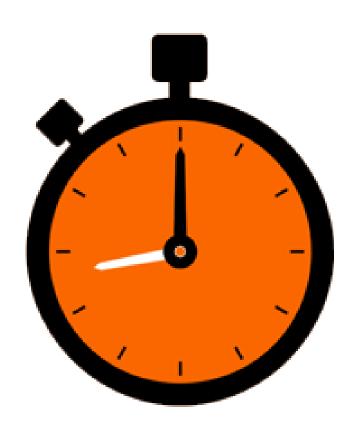

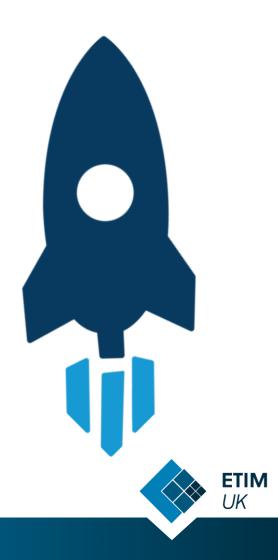

Conceived - against a backdrop of Digital Transformation

- Digitalisation transforming business and consumer behavior
- Impact of e-commerce on bricks and mortar outlets
- Slow adoption of digital by Construction industry and Government Strategy for Digital Built Britain
- Growing number of BIM initiatives



Industry Digitalisation - challenge and opportunity

Wholesalers said:

- 80% big threat from new online entrants
- 73% identify online sales as biggest opportunity
- 40% unfamiliar with BIM

Customers ordering on mobile devices, a major opportunity

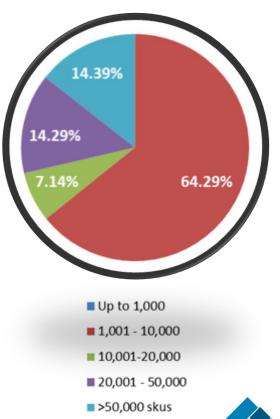

UK Data situation - Manufacturers (2017)

- Majority of EDA affiliated manufacturers >1,000 10,000 SKUs
- 'Containerised' data
- 93% of manufacturers seeing an increased need for digital data
 - 'Richer' / more formats / more delivery pools
- New 'Data Cradle to grave strategy'
- Investment in 'BIM' and central 'PIMs' & 'DAMs'
- New Data roles: Chief Data Officer

What is **ETIM???**

- Started life in Netherlands in 1991
 - Electro-Technical Information Model

- Growth in new countries and new sectors
 - European Technical Information Model
- 2015 USA & Canada join
 - ETIM Technical Information Model (ETIM)



2017 - Unknown acronym to industry jargon

- EDA becomes a member of ETIM International –
 National Organisation for UK and commits to becoming the promoter and guardian of the standard in UK
- ETIM launched to electro-technical sector
- Circa 50 Company specific visits and ETIM-ready audits
- Advisory Group formed
- Communication Channels created:
 - Website, LinkedIN, Regular feature in Taking Stock, press briefings and articles
- Liaison with ETIM International via General Assembly and Technical Committee

2018 - Anglicise and Standardise

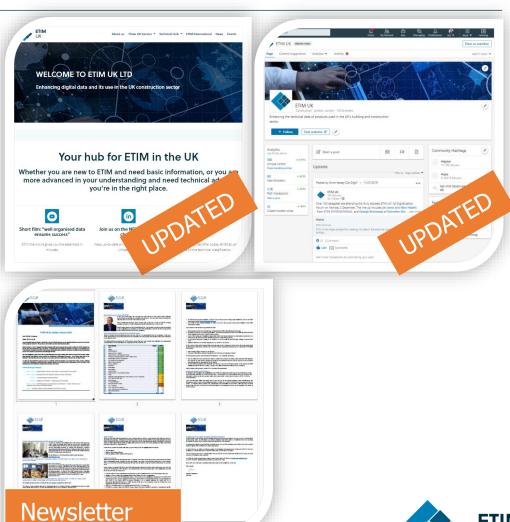
- Product Working Groups

- Advisory Group continues to meet

ETIM UK Ltd.

- ETIM UK Ltd is the National Organisation for ETIM in UK
- Complies with Statutes of ETIM International
- Represents UK at ETIM International Committees
- Scope of ETIM UK is wider than Electro Technical (EDA)
 - Electro-technical
 - HVAC and Sanitary;
 - Building materials;
 - Tools, hardware and site supplies;
 - Shipbuilding (NL only)
- Agnostic, independent and must support other sectors and non-members





ETIM UK Ltd. (continued)

 Promote the adoption of the ETIM data Standard in all ETIM Sectors in UK

- Wider links with other data Standards and initiatives in UK:
 - eClass and UNSPSC
 - Building Smart Data Dictionary (bSDD)

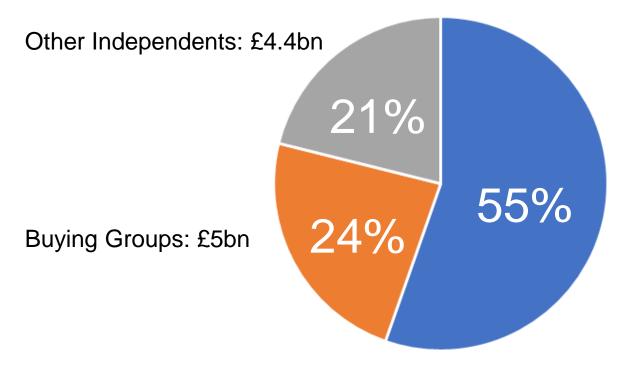

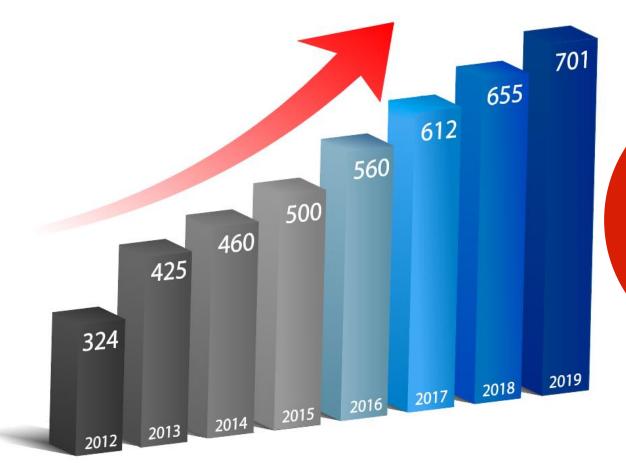

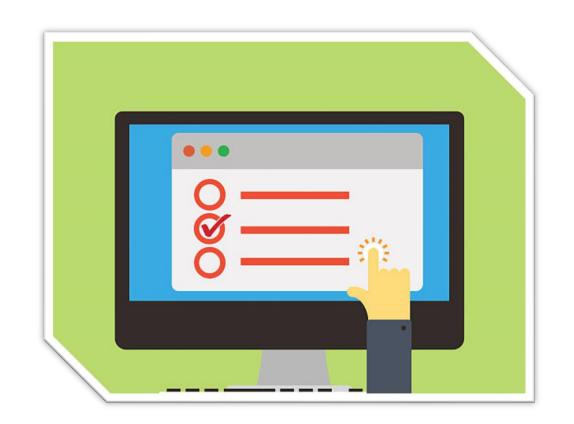

Why the BMF is supporting ETIM



BMF Product Data Poll of members:

- 65% of respondents planned to launch/increase online business in the next two years
- **53% of respondents** said that they have difficulty in obtaining product data from their suppliers in an easily usable format
- 94% of respondents said it would be helpful to have readily available structured product data

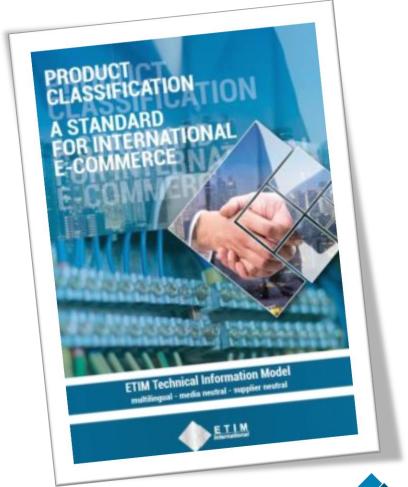




Why the BMF is supporting ETIM

What is involved? ETIM-UK - BMF Project Phases



- Phase 1:
 - Implementing sector ETIM team and structure; communication to the sector
- Phase 2:
 - Developing the ETIM Standard for the sector: Technical Product Information
 - Phase 2.1: Translate/Anglicise existing standard
 - Phase 2.2: Adapting for UK Market sector Adding classes and clarifying
- Phase 3: ETIM Management and development with Members Further refinement and assistance with creation and implementation
- Phase 4: Potential Industry products database with ETIM at its heart.



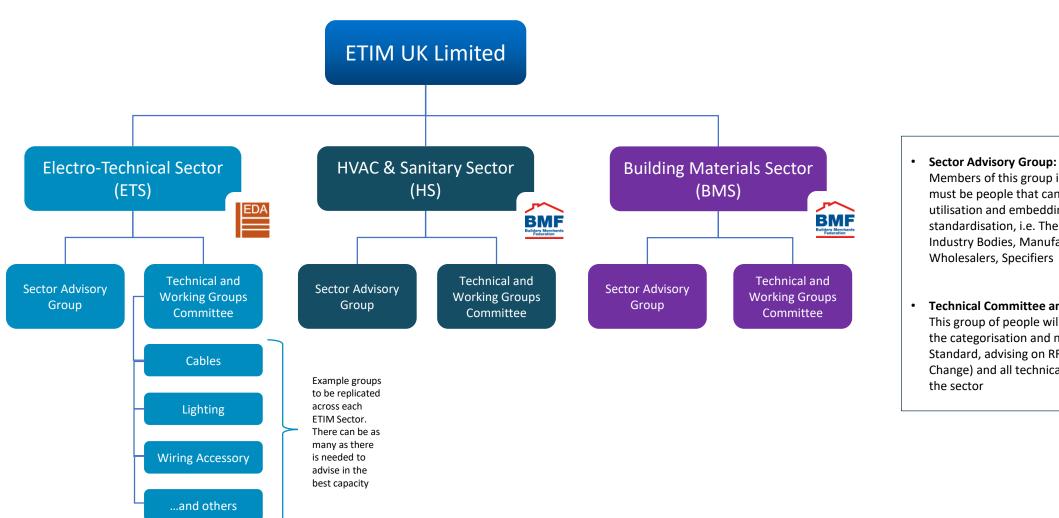

ETIM UK - Structure



- Members of this group is by invite only and must be people that can influence the utilisation and embedding of the ETIM standardisation, i.e. The Value Chain -Industry Bodies, Manufacturers, Wholesalers, Specifiers
- Technical Committee and Working groups: This group of people will be responsible for the categorisation and naming of ETIM Standard, advising on RFC (request for Change) and all technical matter relating to



EDA Role & Status of EDA Members in ETIM UK Ltd

- EDA is responsible for the electro-technical sector of ETIM UK Ltd and will continue its work in this sector
- All EDA members and affiliates are Associate Members of ETIM UK Ltd Electro-technical Sector

ETIM UK Associate Members have:

- influence in the structure and translation of the ETIM Standard
- technical support and advice from ETIM UK
- access to ETIM CMT Tool and other Tools to configure their PIM Systems
- regular communication from ETIM UK
- ETIM-ready audits
- Annual forum



Immediate next steps for ETIM UK Ltd

- Supporting BMF in their start-up phase
- Co-ordinate further standardisation and anglicisation including preparation for ETIM Version 8 due in September 2020
- On-going communication and awareness raising
- Forging links with other standards and organisations, especially BIM

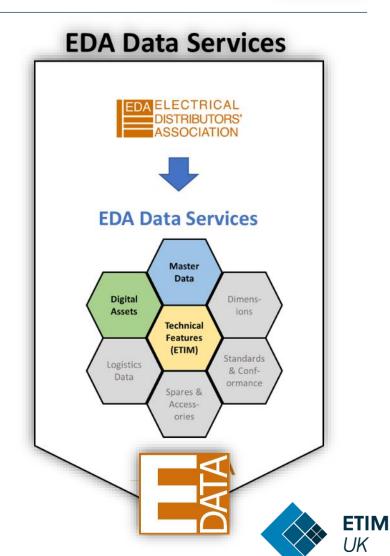


EDA Data Services Ltd.

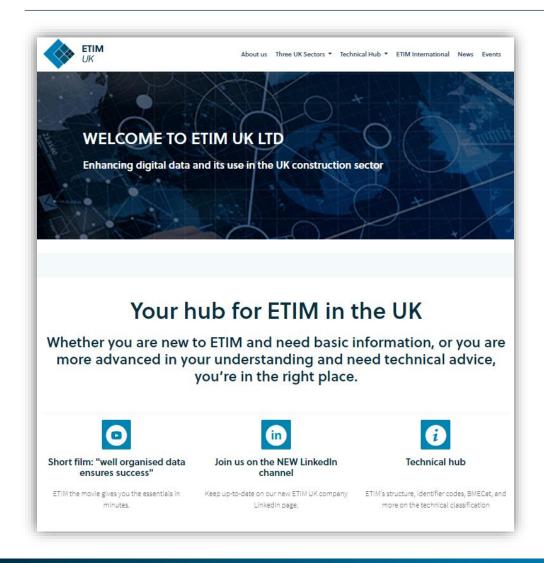


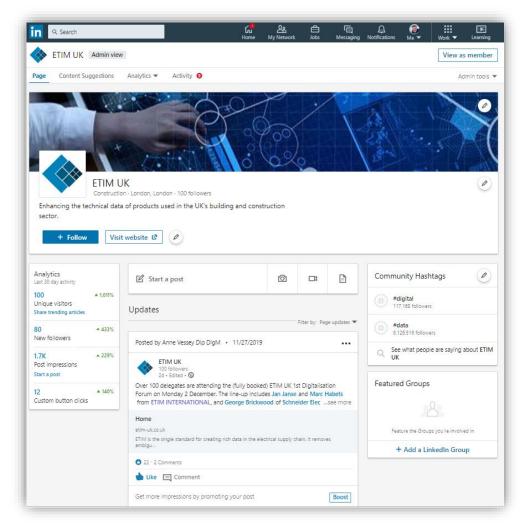

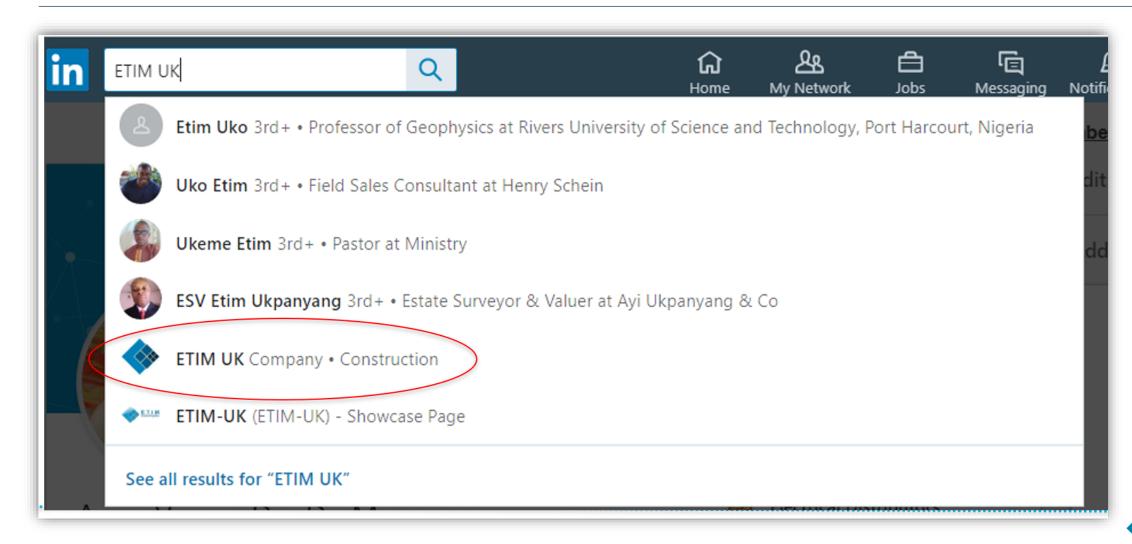
